

Mondays with the Prof Feb 1 2021 Q/A

- During our Q&A, the question arose about the chart on 'Natural Knowledge' and whether or not postmodernism would see the chart differently, since a postmodernist believes that the 'human mind' determines reality. The simple answer is yes. Yes, they would since the worldview of postmodernism believes reality is not understood from what is 'outside' themselves but they 'themselves' determine what is true and right according to the feelings and opinions, not according to objective facts that exist outside of themselves.
- The importance of worldviews was another key topic discussed. One person suggested that there should be an assignment for everyone to find a worldview during the week and then report back the following week. Though the assignment was not required, it demonstrated that the group saw the need to begin spotting the worldviews of others. Too often, people, including Christians, just "accept" other people's ideas and beliefs without considering what people are actually saying. This eventually led into the conversation of a current controversy of Christians knowing the worldviews of political politicians.
